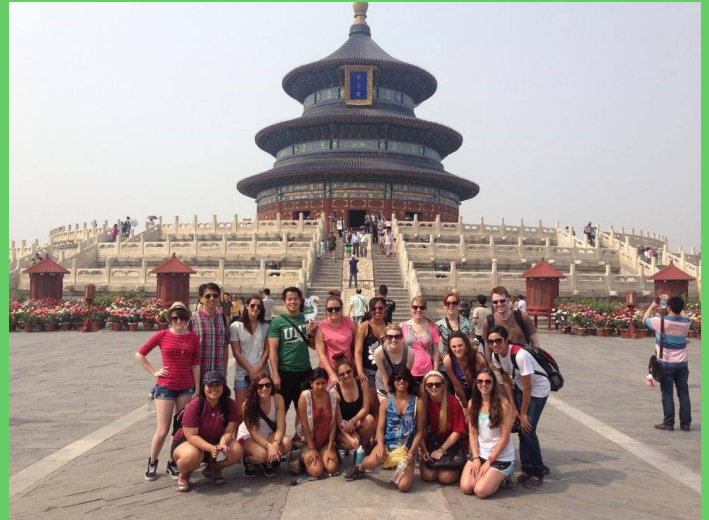

News from our faculty

Dr. Shelley Riggs was awarded the status of fellow in the American Psychological Association Division 43, The Society for Family Psychology.

Dr. Wang took 15 undergraduate and 5 psychology graduate students on the first study-abroad trip during the 2014 Maymester. The group spent 16 days in Beijing, China. This program was sponsored by Beijing Normal University (BNU) where they stayed in dormitory building and used their classroom facility for seminars.

The counseling psychology program will continue fundraising for Dr. Kaminski's nephew, Nathan (introduced in the spring newsletter) until September 30, 2014. A primary goal is to raise enough money for Nathan to get a synthesized speech generating device (similar to Stephen Hawking). AND NOVEL THOUGHTS (so far Nathan has only been able to communicate with his family, friends & teachers in a "multiple choice format").
