Improving Remote Breathalyzer Procedures used by Clinicians and Researchers to Remotely Monitor Alcohol Use (1R21AA029641-01A1):

<u>Study Responsibilities:</u> Assisting in participant recruitment, scheduling, and screening for the study. Conducting drug/pregnancy tests during screening. Installing SCRAM bracelet on participants during enrollment visits. Registering participants with Soberlink devices via smart phone app and connecting their account with our study database for data storage and collection.

Assisting with participant bloodspots during weekly visits, including bringing bloodspots to the negative 80°c freezer to be stored for later analyses. Messaging participants daily feedback texts for their daily samples.

Validation of a Novel Wearable Alcohol Detection Device

Study Responsibilities: Pilot testing using two new transdermal alcohol devices: SOBRsafe wrist monitor and SOBRcheck desktop device. Verifying milliliter dose of Everclear before administration to participants. Monitoring participant behavior in lab after administration. Breathalyzing and conducting SOBRcheck scans every fifteen minutes until BrAC reached 0.000% two times. Recording breathalyzer readings and time of samples for multiple participants at once.

General Lab Responsibilities: Maintaining a clean and organized work environment. Organization and creation of data spreadsheets to be shared with collaborating teams. Creating shared files with community resources for recruitment events. Regular data uploads for NIH progress tracking. Training new research assistants on various study protocols, running participants, data entry, community recruitment processes. Data entry, cleaning, and validity checks across all studies. Organizing and creating REDCap to help filter and track participant progress. Importing Qualtrics data into REDCap. Conducting accuracy checks on Dräger breathalyzer devices. Tracking lab inventory and coordinating purchasing with administrative personnel as needed. Use of passive and active recruitment strategies to reach vulnerable populations.

<u>Recruitment, Social Media, and Web Design Lead:</u> Responsible for creating and maintaining recruitment assignments and events for undergraduate/post-bac research assistants. Creating and organizing new contact methods to assist in participant recruitment and retention. Established lab social media presence to encourage community engagement.
