Instructions:

1. Review the list of scholarships and awards on our website to determine your eligibility.

2. Prepare your application.

To apply for a scholarship or award, you must submit an application cover page (see last page), CV, and essay specific to the scholarship or award. In addition, the thesis, dissertation, and teaching fellow awards require one letter of recommendation.

3. Submit your application via email to psyc-grad@unt.edu no later than March 5th, 2024, at 11:59pm. Late submissions will not be considered.

To submit your application, please email your application materials (i.e., application cover page, CV, essay, and letter of recommendation-if applicable) to psyc-grad@unt.edu.

You will need to submit each scholarship or award application in a SEPARATE email. In each email, include your name and the name of the scholarship in the subject line. For example, if you are applying for the dissertation award, the subject of the email will be as follows: "Ernest Harrell Outstanding Dissertation Award." If you also apply for the Anna Wright Memorial Scholarship, you will submit a second email with the subject, "Ernest Harrell Anna Wright Memorial Scholarship."

Additional Information:

We encourage all students to apply for dissertation, thesis, and scholarly publication awards, if eligible. Beyond this, however, you may only apply for two additional awards.

Also, if you have won a specific award in the past, then you are no longer eligible for that award.
